Currently 81 operators publishing to BODS (65 last week)

291 published datasets on BODS but these might comprise hundreds of services

Number of services to be confirmed of 16000- working on the dataset and measures

Location data:

Feeds for approximately 9500 vehicles (of 32,500) – will rise to 16000 in the next few weeks

Fares data:

Currently 69 datasets. Number of services to be confirmed of 16000

An AVL feed will temporarily drop into a 'data unavailable' state if none of their fleet are currently sending data (if no data is received within 30 seconds). Data will be available again once the bus starts moving again.

Bus Open Data – Summary

- Overall 81 operators publishing timetables, 39 publishing location data and 19 publishing fares data
- We have subscriptions to feeds for up to 9500 vehicles to increase to 15000 when Vix publish
- Fares and Agent Mode has now been released to production, all BODS functionality now online
- Work continues to provide capacity and crowding data to third party app developers via BODS for C19
- Overall 59 of 87 LTAS have updated NaPTAN datasets now and DQ work continues
- Discussions continue with regulators on enforcement strategy and letter to be issued to operators
- Statisticians continue work on development of BODS Scorecard to support benefits tracking
- Programme plans and Communications plans being finalised and contracts set up for 2021.



Bus Open Data – Summary

- Ticketer, Optibus and Omnibus providing extensive support to operators to publish timetable and location data
- Overall 81 operators publishing timetables, 39 publishing location data and 19 publishing fares data
- Agent Mode launch means that local authorities can now support small operators to publish data
- We have subscriptions to feeds for up to 9500 vehicles to increase to 15000 when Vix publish
- If you have a capacity and crowding feed, Ticketer will not charge to provide this to BODS (CBSSG)
- Fares and Agent Mode has now been released to production, all BODS functionality now online
- We are working with tech suppliers and have confirmed the version of TXC is BODS TXC 2.4 v1.0
- Work continues to provide capacity and crowding data to third party app developers via BODS for C19
- Support desk currently being set up for operators for 2021
- Overall 59 of 87 LTAS have updated NaPTAN datasets now and DQ work continues
- We have communicated with OTC, DVSA and also published in guidance that 2021 is transitional
- Discussions continue with regulators on enforcement strategy and letter to be issued to operators
- We're working with Traveline on the BODS and TNDS transition plan for 2021 and beyond
- Statisticians continue work on development of BODS Scorecard to support benefits tracking
- Local authorities are receiving more information and workshops to help them become agents
- Programme plans and Communications plans being finalised and contracts set up for 2021.
- The updated BODS implementation guide will be published shortly.

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
